Players Requesting Approval

Registration:

- Photos- Please check all photos are in the system and are the correct way around.
- Activate players – Please ensure all players are active on Monday morning ready for printing. If players are not active, they will be removed, and it will be the club's responsibility to re-submit them on the post registration form.

General:

- BIBS – Wearing of Bib's in the technical area will not be compulsory this year. This is due to being unable to share gear between players. BDAFA's Directive regarding wearing of Bib's will be:
All players in the technical areas during games must cover their playing shirt with their own shirt or jacket which is to be different to the playing shirt. Players must adhere to all other technical area regulations.
- Team Sheets- Team sheets will not require a paid stamp at the canteen prior to games due to changes regarding Match Official Payments. Teams are still required to have a Ground Marshal Signature.

- Ground Marshalls- Due to the number of foreign games and lack of volunteers, for this year only, BDAFA will implement the following directive for Ground Marshals:

Where there is a foreign game at a Bankstown field, it will be the home team's responsibility to supply a Ground Marshal and they should be noted on the team sheet. Should there be an official referee, they are to also introduce themselves to the referees prior to the commencement of the game. Should there be an AAM's game without spectators, there the home team will provide a team representative (player that will act as the Ground Marshal while playing. They will be noted on the team sheets and present themselves to the Referee prior to the commencement of the game

- Ground Marshals should not share bibs
